Our overarching guideline for participants in the Bay and Reef Summer Kids Day Camp is respect. We expect that participants will listen to the staff members, follow safety guidelines, and treat each other and the environment around them kindly.

Our goal is to help participants increase their knowledge and appreciation of the natural environment. To do so, we believe that it is necessary to give thoughtful attention to the child's social and emotional well-being. An integral part of the well-being is the behavior of the child within a small group.

Elizabeth Jolin and Xavier Figueredo (and other employed staff) have years of experience educating and entertaining adults, families and children on the water and in the classroom. We acknowledge small group behavioral challenges. We keep in mind that the child is good, even if the behavior is inappropriate, and we coach participants to behave in ways that are safe and respectful. We find that most children have a wonderful time, and that our days and charters run smoothly. We do on occasion come upon problematic behavior. We are interested in discussing any behavioral issues with parents before or during the program. Please come to us with concerns about the behavior of your child or other participants.

We may turn to you, the parents, if we are feeling challenged by a particular behavior. Before the program, it is helpful for us to be alerted of special needs, including those that have an impact on a child's behavior. It is also helpful when parents share with us strategies that work well with their child.

Bay and Reef Summer Kids Day Camp Pick up and Drop Off Schedule

Parents or guardians should plan to drop kids off 15 minutes prior to the start of the daily activities to insure best use of campers time. Pick up must occur within 20 minutes of scheduled program end time.

Bay and Reef Day Camp Checklist

What to Wear:

- Swim suit: plan to wear your swimsuit to camp with shorts and t-shirt over top
- Sun screen: put on your first layer of sunscreen at home and we will provide the rest throughout the day
- Hat: wear a hat every day
- Sunglasses: wear sunglasses if you have them
- Shoes: wear shoes every day and preferably boating shoes (no floppy flip flops)

What to Bring:

- LUNCH: bring a healthy and satisfying lunch
- Towel
- Raincoat
- Dry t-shirt

Issues to Consider:

- Cell phones: cell phone use will not be permitted until the daily session is completed or unless there is an emergency
- Cameras: participants are encouraged to use underwater or disposable cameras during camp considering the daily activities take place in a saltwater environment
- Electronic toys or games: electronic toys and games will be prohibited during the program
